Election of the Integration Council of the City Velbert on 13.09.2020

On **13.09.2020** the Integration Council of the city Velbert is elected.

The Integration Council is composed of elected members and council members who are delegated to the body by the City Council. The Integration Council is the municipal representation of all inhabitants of Velbert with a migration background.

Its members actively shape integration policy and integration work. They...

- ... communicate the interests and concerns of immigrants in Velbert with other municipal bodies and structures of the city administration,
- ... take part in the work of municipal committees and working groups and assume an advisory function there and
- ... support the planning and implementation of various events and projects.

The body is elected for a term of 5 years.

Vote and thus be able to decide on the composition of the body:

- **Persons who do not possess a German passport,**
- **Stateless,**
- **Germans who have another foreign nationality in addition to the German one,**
- **Naturalised,**
- **Children born in Germany to foreign parents,**
- **Non-German EU citizens and**
- **Resettlers,**

if they are **16 years old** on 13.09.2020, have legally **resided in Germany for at least one year** and have had their **main residence in Velbert at least since 28.08.2020**.

All persons who are allowed to vote will receive an election notification by mail from the city Velbert until 23.08.2020.

The elections of the Integration Council will take place on 13.09.2020 together with the local elections **in all polling stations!**

The members to be elected have come together in 4 lists this year:

- 1. International Social Democratic List (ISDL)**
- 2. Diversity in Velbert (ViV)**
- 3. Velbert International List (VIL)**
- 4. Kurdish Democratic List (KDL)**
